Program Hope serves low income families in the Bucks County and Northeast Philadelphia areas. Program Hope is a non-profit organization that serves both children and adults with special needs. Prior to the Non-Profit designation, it worked under the umbrella of other organizations.

The program provides different activities, such as cultural social gatherings for disabled youth. Other programs that are offered are structured to develop self-esteem and encourage self-expression. Cultural activities include trips to places such as the Pennsylvania Renaissance Faire, the White House, and the Harrisburg State Capital. These trips provide a social experience and teach lessons of history.

In addition, Program Hope has art classes every other week, where the group gets together under the guidance of a professional art instructor and creates works of art. Art lessons are provided as a form of therapy for people with special needs.

Vocal lessons are also available. Everyone loves to sing and these lessons provide the opportunity for self-expression through music. Other programs include rhythm and music, where different dance steps are taught, as well as the use of music for relaxation. All of this takes place at Art Studio Palette, which is located on 11026 Rennard Street, Philadelphia Pa, 19116.
